APPOINTMENT NON-COMPLIANCE CONTRACT

PEI understands that not showing and late cancellations for appointments sometimes cannot be helped. As soon as you are aware that you will be unable to keep your appointment, please notify the office immediately. Patients who no show or cancel with less than 24 hours notice of their scheduled appointment will be charged a \$25.00 fee for which the patient, not the insurance company, is responsible. This fee must be paid in full before PEI will allow another appointment to be scheduled.

FACILITY AGREEMENT

Presbyterian ear institute (PEI) will make every attempt to make the wait comfortable, but we do insist that clients who are coming to Presbyterian Ear Institute for audiology testing (hearing tests), speech and language evaluation or therapy visits remain in the lobby while waiting for their provider. The provider will come to the lobby to accompany their client(s) to their office. Guardians of minor clients must remain on Presbyterian Ear Institute property while the patient is being seen. No exceptions will be made.

All patients/visitors to PEI must sign in at the front desk prior to any appointments.

Presbyterian ear institute (PEI) has several programs including a *parent infant program*, *speech and language therapy program*, and *Presbyterian Ear Institute Oral School*. The school has a playground on site, as well as classrooms and a learning center. Due to insurance liability these areas are for enrolled students of Presbyterian Ear Institute and their families upon staff supervision only.

COVID-19 Patient Protections

Dear Families and Friends of PEI.

During this challenging time of the COVID-19 outbreak, Presbyterian Ear Institute is making some temporary changes to keep our patients, staff and community safer. We are closely monitoring the situation and following guidance from our public health officials and government agencies. Please read on to learn what to do prior to coming to PEI for your appointment.

The coronavirus spreads very easily. Therefore, before you come in, please contact us to reschedule your appointment if you:

- Have a cough and fever of 100.4 or higher.
- Are experiencing shortness of breath.
- Have traveled outside the state within the past two weeks.
- Have had contact with someone that has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

I understand that you may feel concern or have some uncertainty about attending your appointment. To help ease some of those feelings, I want to share with you the measures we are taking for everyone's safety.

For scheduled appointments:


- Number of attendees: Please limit the number of persons attending the appointment to no more than two adults and one child.
- Screening: We will screen temperature for all persons entering the building. Anyone with a temperature reading of 99.5 will be turned away.
- Masking: Everyone entering our building with need to wear a face covering. If you do not bring one, we will provide one. We will also have hand sanitizer and gloves available in the entranceway.
- Comprehensive Cleaning: Our staff is doing extra sanitizing of all surfaces, especially the work spaces, exam rooms, bathrooms and waiting area. Our providers will be sanitizing their areas between patients.
- Social Distancing: Seating in our waiting room will be marked at a distance of at least 6 feet from other seats. In hallways, we have implemented a one-way traffic flow with arrows to guide our staff and patients.
